

Dear Supporters of the For We Care Outreach Network Society,

Our Board of Directors and Management Team wish you a Blessed Christmas and God's guidance every step of the way through the next year. God has been good to us during 2013, through you.

We have been blessed with a wonderful Donor Base who enabled us to provide their designated funding for the Mutengene Hospital addition; the HESCO water plant; equipment for Vitreoretinal Services; Scholarships for Seminary Students; Salary Support for Pastors; and where most needed.

Through the generosity of one Donor, we were provided with \$70,000 designated as a Matching Grant for the construction of the Mbingo Medical Student Hostel (our latest project) to house undergraduate medical students who come to Mbingo for their core clinical rotations in a Christian environment before graduating. Because of FWC, they were able to have the ground-breaking ceremony and commence construction. The estimated cost of the Hostel will be approximately \$140,000.

The Mutengene Hospital addition is progressing as construction funds become available. Dr. Dennis Palmer shared the following need for the Mutengene Project: "The biggest issue the hospital is now facing is with cash flow to continue working on the project. The HB [Health Board] currently has held up all their construction. ... is [it] possible for FWC to advance some funds? ... otherwise the project will be halted for a while."

Jeff Brown is our Vice President – Brown Team Water Projects. These projects currently include Sun Safe Water, and the supervision of the HESCO facility supplying the needs of the Mutengene Hospital, as one of its important services. Jeff's Team has provided the HESCO facility with a number of critical equipment and maintenance parts. In addition some team members will be visiting the Cameroon facility early in 2014 to carry out the obligations that they have assumed.

We are also pleased to welcome two new Members to our Management Team: Esther Link as Director (Vice-Chair) and Vice-President of Church and Charity Mobilization; and Brian Link as CEO (President).
